LAND AND WATERS PRESERVATION TRUST GRANT APPLICATION

BACKROUND

Land and Waters (L&W) is a component fund of the Initiative Foundation (IF) and serves as a philanthropic vehicle for accumulating and distributing financial resources to benefit those in the area of the Pine River Watershed. It was established through a partnership between Whitefish Area Property Owners Association (WAPOA), Pine River Watershed Alliance (PRWA) and IF.

Grants will be made to 501c3 non-profits such as the Whitefish Area Property Owners Association (WAPOA), other lake associations in the watershed, the Pine River Watershed Alliance (PRWA), or local units of government that serve the Pine River Watershed.

Grants will be made only for proposals that fit one or more of the Funding Priorities listed below.

FUNDING PRIORITIES

L&W will accept and consider funding proposals that fit within the following priorities:

- Implement projects that enhance and protect surface and aquifer water quality in the Pine River watershed.
- Support sustainable riparian land management practices.
- Protect habitat for native plants and animals.

NOTE: Ongoing maintenance and capital expenditures will not be supported.

PROCESS

- 1. Email bcourneya1@gmail.com to request an application form.
- 2. Complete application form. Be sure to use the form dated *December 2024*.
- 3. Send completed form to Barb Courneya at bcourneya1@gmail.com
- 4. The L&W Advisory Committee will do a review and provide you with feedback regarding the application in March 2025.
- 5. If the application meets guidelines and has merit, additional information may be requested.
- 6. A final review will be done by the L&W Advisory Board in March.
- 7. Grant requestors will be contacted and informed of final decisions

TIMELINE

- 1. Grant Application Form submission period is December 1, 2024, through March 1, 2025.
- 2. The deadline for additional information, if requested by Land and Waters, is March 15, 2025.
- 3. Grant award date is April 1, 2025.
- 4. Total Grants Annual Budget total grant awards not to exceed \$15,000.
 - a. Considering the annual budget amount, grant applications requesting up to \$5,000 are encouraged, with larger project amounts considered
- 5. The intention is that the proposed project will be completed in 2025.
